

1.1 Download

GLOBE software is available here : <https://doi.org/10.17882/70460>

1.2 Requirements

- Operating system: Windows 10, Ubuntu
- System: 64 bits
- RAM: 16Go recommended (2Go minimum)
- Graphic adapter: minimum 2007 NVIDIA recommended

WARNING | Check if your graphic cards are up to date.

IMPORTANT | Using an old version of your graphic driver can lead to a JVM crash as soon as GLOBE tries to display any OpenGL view.

1.3 Installation

Windows and Linux

- Unzip the file in a directory of your choice
- Click on globe.exe (windows) or the globe executable file (linux)

Mac OS

IMPORTANT | Mac Os platform is no longer supported.

1.4 Uninstall procedure

To erase some temporary files and save some space, before the uninstall procedure you can clean GLOBE files in cache with the  **Cache Manager**.

Then users just need to delete the *GLOBE* software directory to uninstall it.

1.5 Update procedure (Windows)

In some special cases (low bandwidth conditions, improvement of current version, ...) it is quicker to upgrade your version than installing a full version of Globe. Then you should follow the upgrade procedure.

1. Ask for a patch file to the support team giving your current Globe version
2. Click on tools/ApplyPatch.bat (windows) in your current Globe version to launch the patch applier utility

3. Fill the different fields and push on "Apply patch" button
4. A new full version of Globe is generated with the provided name
